

SEWERAGE & DRAINAGE GROUP MINUTES

Meeting 12/04/2013

Present: Roy Seabrook, Jack Moss

1. The immediate objectives were agreed. These were
 - i. Which plant services Southbourne.
 - ii Which other communities use this plant.
 - iii What is the maximum and the current capacity of the plant.
 - iv what is the domestic, industrial and other breakdown of usage.
 - v What proposed developments are to be added to this plant.
 - vi Obtain or draw up a plan of the drainage and sewerage system of the parish together with pipe capacities.
 - vii Obtain the regulations governing overload capacities.
 - viii Obtain details of present frequency of overload and projections given trend to wetter conditions.

2. It was decided that the first step should be to contact Chichester District Council and then to contact Southern Water and perhaps West Sussex County Council.

3. A meeting with Sue Payne of District was arranged for 24th April. E-mail contact with Dave Lowsley of District is also being established.

4. When Southern Water are contacted in may be a good idea to include a tour of the local plant, perhaps in conjunction with adjacent parishes.

5. Roy said that he would ask Rowena about profession help to analyse collected data at the Housing Group meeting on the 16th April.

6. Roy Seabrook said that he would also make contact with the Harbour Conservancy and the Environment Agency.
