

## Minutes Transport Focus Group

07 October 2013

Attendees: Jack Moss (JM) Geoff Talbot (GT)

Transport Group met following the steering group meeting of 07October 2013.

Matters arising affecting Transport included the following:

- Information received by GT at Stake Holders meeting suggested that licensing rules prevent the bus company from picking up passengers in West Sussex on route 36A and carrying them to destinations in Hampshire.  
Action: JM to request Sandra James to arrange meeting between WSCC Highways (Bill Leith), Emsworth & District Motor Services (Caren Austin Lea) Traransport FG to investigate this situation and any possible solution.
- Now known that the No. 11 Bus Service cancelled due to lack of funding.  
Action: JM to request from Bus Company the viable financial threshold needed to re-establish this service.
- Information received from Clive Robey at Network Rail at the Stakeholders meeting suggests that an increase in the number of houses built to the north of the railway line may trigger the requirement for automatic level crossing gates at Inlands Road.  
Action: JM to enquire as to what the tipping point may be in terms of number of dwellings and how upgraded crossing would be funded.
- GT suggested that information as to the number of road trips each new property would generate should be sought. This to measure the increased traffic likely to use local road network in Parish, especially Stein Road, and other roads feeding onto A259. The Jacobs Chichester Traffic Study makes assumptions on loadings onto the Fishbourne Roundabout at peak and non peak periods therefore must make assumptions regarding the total trips generated in the Southbourne Traffic Zone..  
Action: JM to request Councillors Sandra James and Bruce Finch to enquire as to the rule of thumb measurement WSCC Highways Dept. may use for trip generation per new dwelling in order to inform housing group of likely impact of various SHLAA sites..

Matters arising affecting Transport following the Stake Holders meeting:

- As only data available from the facillitators is in a raw form at this time further discussion was deferred until more comprehensive data is made available. At the Steering Group meeting Rowena Tylor undertook to provide this.
- JM reported that at the Stake Holders meeting a representative from Funtington PC commented that build in the North of Southbourne

Parish would/may lead to "Rat Running" onto the B2178 Funtingdon Road

Action: JM to remind Councillor James of this.

No date set for a further meeting as JM & GT meet on a regular basis socially and arrange formal meetings as and when necessary.
